Job Description

Position: Water Infrastructure Coordinator

Context:

The French NGO better with water has created the social business Shobar Jonno Pani Ltd. and the NGO Water & Life Bangladesh in 2010 and now operating under the trademark of better with water Bangladesh.

The overall objective of BWW Bangladesh is to improve the living conditions of low income communities in depressed urban areas of Bangladesh based on water supply.

W&L and SJP work in close collaboration to implement the program. W&L ensures the implementation of the sanitation & social activities (Hygiene promotion, Fire-fighting, Solid waste management, social survey), while SJP sets up, maintains and operates the water supply network in the targeted areas. Bhashantek water supply network is a pilot and innovative project: the scheme provides metered household connections to slum dwellers with reliable and good quality water, with full recovery of revenues by DWASA. This is the first time in Bangladeshi slums that water is provided through household connection and based on a social enterprise model.

Thanks to the quality of services provided and the efficient billing system, the social enterprise gradually widens its field of action by becoming a multi-services actor, including the waste collection and the sanitation services.

BWW Bangladesh engaged in partnerships with the local communities, authorities, water operator and other development stakeholders.

Tasks & responsibilities:

Development of new projects: Water (90%) & Sanitation (10%)

- Coordinate topographic surveys and technical assessments.
- Design water network projects using software, including infrastructure such as pumping stations, underground tanks, overhead tanks etc.
- Design borehole according to nearby water level assessment.
- Prepare Bill of Quantities and project budgets for water networks and other construction works.
- Assist in the design and installation of electrical infrastructure: meters, lines, pumps, and automation systems.
- Participate actively in the procurement process: identify contractors, request quotations, purchase materials, and follow up on deliveries.
- Determine human resource needs for construction works.
- Coordinate and supervise BWW technical teams and contractors on-site.
- Ensure construction materials are properly stored, organized, and accounted for.

Operation & Maintenance of water services:

- Support activity planning and help prioritize technical team tasks.
- Supervise and assist technical teams in construction, maintenance, and repair of water and sanitation systems.
- Provide technical guidance to Regional Office teams.
- Prepare annual water network preventive and curative maintenance plans.
- Prepare annual water service quality testing plans.
- Oversee water quality testing and provide training on internal methodologies.
- Recommend improvements to installations and processes using available resources.

Prospection & Technical Surveys:

• Conduct technical surveys in informal settlement areas: map existing water networks, identify potential water sources, conduct water quality tests, measure water flow and pressure, etc.

Logistics & Materials Management:

- Maintain organized and clean stock of construction materials and tools.
- Coordinate timely ordering of materials with the Chief Plumber to ensure smooth project execution.
- Support plumbers to maintain stock and take responsibility.

Reporting & GIS:

- Prepare monthly technical activity reports: project progress, number of connections, challenges encountered, solutions proposed, and next month's plan.
- Prepare end-of-installation activity reports.
- Create and update GIS databases for ongoing and completed projects.

Other tasks:

- Perform any additional duties as required by the supervisor.
- Assist the Financial Partners department with donor queries and reports.

Technical Skills:

- Knowledge of water supply networks and sanitation systems, including design and installation of tanks, pipelines, pumps, and automation systems.
- Ability to prepare technical designs, Bills of Quantities, and project budgets for infrastructure projects.
- Proficiency in technical drawing software (AutoCAD, Civil 3D, or equivalent).
- Knowledge of electrical infrastructure related to water systems (meters, lines, pumps, automation).
- Ability to supervise technical teams and contractors, plan activities, and ensure quality of works.
- Familiarity with water quality testing methods and local standards.
- Basic knowledge of GIS/SIG for mapping and monitoring projects.
